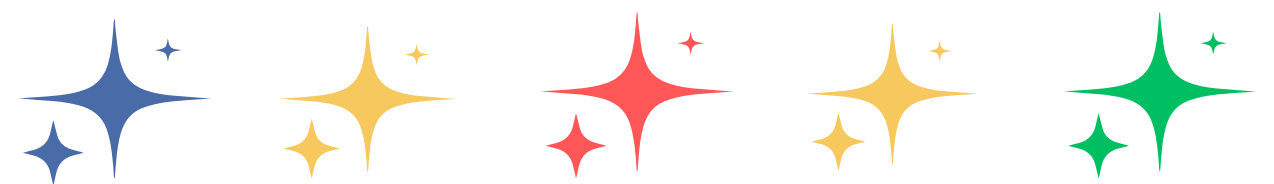
WORLD AUTISM DAY

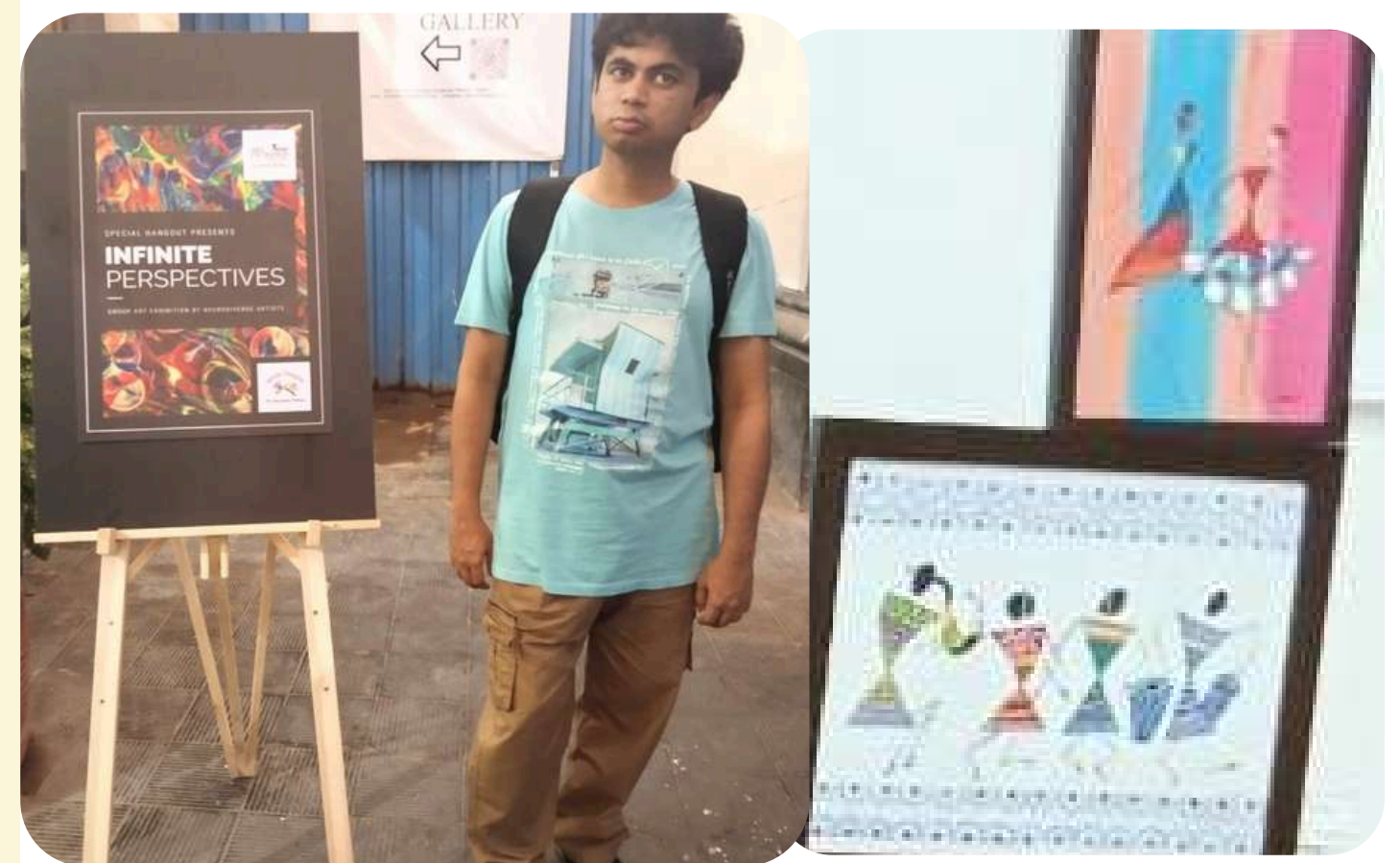
CAPTURING HEARTS @ ZONTA CLUB
